Before you submit your work:

- Have you fulfilled the criteria set in the task?
- Is everything you have included relevant to the task?
- Does the number of words in your piece fit within the criteria?
- Have you used a dictionary to check your spellings, including accents?
- Have you used verbs correctly? Are they in the correct tense? Do they have correct endings?
- Have you checked what gender your nouns are?
- Do your adjectives agree?
- Is your vocabulary varied? Have you used the same word many times? Can you find an alternative?
- Have you included plenty of opinions throughout your work? Have you said why you do/don't like something? Have you used opinions in different tenses? (C'est..., C'était..., Ce sera...)
